MY WONDERING


- Knowing the impact of instruction, why haven't I made the time daily?

- Reflect on what I see in the classrooms



- Calendar






CLASSROOM VISITS



HOW DO I SPEND MY TIME DAILY?




MY DISCOVERIES

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- Purpose When I walk into a classroom, it all clicks. It reminds me of why I became an administrator. I love learning and nothing is more exciting to me than watching students and teachers engage in one another's learning. Sometimes it is overwhelming to me to think about how much impact ONE teacher can have on a student's life path. If the teacher loves Science and truly believes ALL students can learn, it is a game changer for the student sitting in the class feeling inadequate and lost. As I round out my ninth year in administration, I have seen the impact, good and bad, a teacher can have on their students. The teachers who struggle with instructional strategies, feel overwhelmed or just "doesn't get it" need some guidance and help. I believe the instructional time going on in classrooms everyday is the most important focus of an administrator. My purpose is to find more time in my workday to spend more time in the classroom.
- Question (Wondering) Why have I not found time daily for the most important focus as an educational leader? (classroom visits)

Sub questions

- Knowing how important instruction is, why haven't I made the time daily?
 What can I change in my schedule to provide more time for
 - classroom visits?
- What is taking my time daily that can be delegated or adjusted to open up time?
- How will I make sure this is a priority daily?

Method (What will I be doing?)

- I will track reflect on my calendar from August until November and determine what is taking the majority of my time.
- I will work with my assistant principal to see what duties can be shared and/or delegated.
- I will visit a minimum of five classrooms a day for a minimum of ten minutes. (December-January)

- I will visit a minimum of seven classrooms a day for a minimum of ten minutes. (February-March)
- I will keep a journal during these months to reflect on the classrooms visits and/or what is keeping me from these visits.
- I will keep a spreadsheet of my teachers to track the dates of classroom visits.

Data Collection

- Analysis my calendar for what is taking my time
- Analysis my weekly journal on my visits and/or reasons why I didn't get them accomplished.
- Review journal/spreadsheet to see how I can "find" time and/or make more if I am not meeting my goal.

Calendar (timeline)

- August –November
 - Collect data on how I am spending my time daily
- December –January
 - Visit a minimum of five classrooms a day for 10 minutes
 - Keep a journal of my visits
 - Keep a spreadsheet of my classroom/teacher visits
- February –March
 - Visit a minimum of seven classrooms a day for 10 minutes
 - Keep a journal of my visits
 - Keep a spreadsheet of my classroom/teacher visits

Data Analysis

- Analysis August-November calendar of how my time is spent daily
- Analysis spreadsheet of teacher visits
- Reflect on daily journal
